Dear Shri Bondre,

This has reference to the discussions held with Prof. U. U. Kharat from Shri Shivaji Sciences & Arts College, Chikhli on 1.9.1992 and with yourself on 2.9.1992 in the presence of Shri A. N. Purushetti, Vice-Principal, T.K. College of Engineering & Technology, Warananagar wherein we discussed the compliances made in respect of AICTE requirements conveyed to you vide our letter of even number dated 24.8.1992 and our notes on file dated 1.9.1992.

In view of the discussions, you are requested to kindly:

1. Submit a certificate from an authority of the Government of Maharashtra regarding land conversion for the purpose of construction of the College buildings thereon and for other uses of the proposed College of Engineering.
2. Carry out appointment of atleast 8 faculty members to cater to the 1st year classes and submit proof thereof.
3. Give an agreement from the Board of trustees that the Management/Governing Body for the College would be constituted as per the guidelines of the AICTE (attached). You will kindly ensure that the Chairman is appointed as laid down in the guidelines and also that you would have atleast one senior person with Engineering background to act as the Member-Secretary of this Management/Governing Body.
4. Appoint a senior person with adequate experience of establishment and management of an Engineering College as a Consultant to help the Society establish the proposed College as per AICTE norms and standards.

It is noted that the revised letter of Government of Maharashtra No. PEC 7091/55772/(4572)/TE-1 dated 1.9.1992 has now specified the disciplines and the intakes permitted for your College. These are Civil Engg, Mechanical Engg, Computer Engg, and Industrial Electronics Engg with intake of 60 in each discipline. It has now been decided during the discussion that the College would start only 2 disciplines (Computer Engg and Industrial Electronics) from 1992-93 with annual intakes of 60 in each and would approach the AICTE during 1992-93 for substitute disciplines for Mechanical and Civil Engg with due

approval of the State Government. This was agreed to by yourself based on the views put forth by Shri Purushetti and the undersigned. You have also agreed that during 1992-93 you would not start classes in any of the two disciplines in case the admissions in any of the disciplines on the last date of closing of admissions is less than 40. This was decided to ensure that due to subsequent drop outs the conduct of the course does not become unviable especially during the 3rd and 4th years of the particular batch.


It was also agreed that you would make appropriate arrangements for attendance of the workshops and laboratory classes by your students at the College at Shegaon by providing atleast one bus for their to and fro journey. Any inconvenience caused to the students on this account hampering their attendance of the classes and therefore ultimately diluting the standards of the education would be viewed seriously.

It was also agreed that the presently available hostel with 50 bed capacity shall be reserved for Engineering students only.

You are requested to take further necessary on the above.
